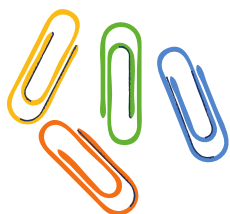
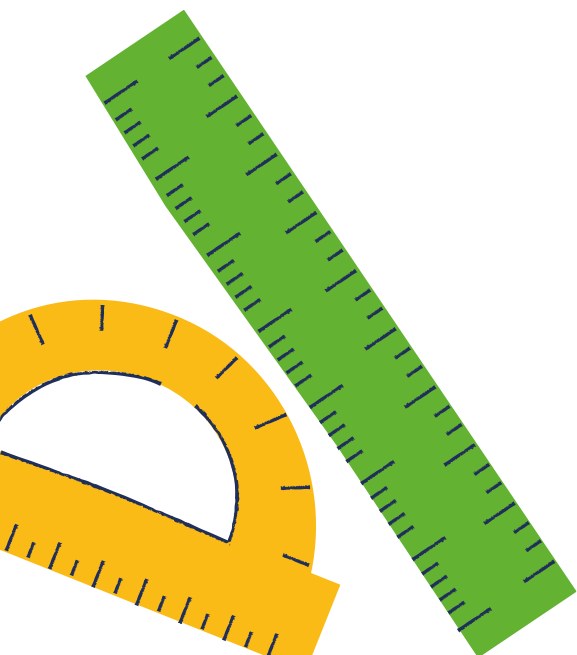

| 1 | When is the deadline to have the school supplies to VSSC for distribution? | The VSSC collects school supplies year-round so you are welcome to drop off your donation at any time. The fall semester typically starts the last week in August and that is when most students will be gathering needed supplies. |
